#### Flying Field Update

Message from Mike

Paul and I paid a visit to the field this morning and were pleased to find the strip in a better state than we feared. The animals have been moved out and while there are inevitably some hoof prints on our strip, they are much fewer and less severe than what we were faced with last year.

We will address repairs once we start mowing but in the meantime the area is useable for planes without undercarriage or with Tundra type tyres. As you might imagine the field is very wet everywhere and the field entrance is not passable by vehicle for now. You can park outside the field (a couple of cars or so max) but be very careful not to get stuck or block the road. Once in the field bear right to avoid the worst of the mud on your way over to the strip.

If the step over fence near the farmyard is locked, just ask anyone in the yard and someone will be able to unlock it for you. Apparently there are plans for the council to

fit a new gate at some point but don't hold your breath. If anything changes we will issue further instructions.

#### Membership 2025

BMFA and Club fees are now over due. BMFA is £49 and Club £25 Working from last years membership of 24 members we have 9 yet to pay Club fees with some yet to pay BMFA fees.

If you are not intending to rejoin our club this year please let me know and I won't start pestering you for money.

#### Flyer ID Information from BMFA

Our Club currently only has **13** members who are legal to fly so far this year. If you have a Flyer ID and haven't yet sent the information to Bob please do so ASAP. If you haven't got a Flyer ID and the Operator ID on your model you can't fly at the club field

Under the new laws that are now in place a Flyer ID is now compulsory. (It's FREE)

If you fly drones or model aircraft with a take off mass over 250gm outdoors (excluding Control Line) you must now have a valid CAA Flyer ID. Any weight with camera fitted.

There are now only 2 ways to obtain a Flyer ID, you must pass either the CAA DMARES test or the BMFA (RCC). For further information please see <a href="https://rcc.bmfa.uk/caa-ids">https://rcc.bmfa.uk/caa-ids</a>

There is a lot of information from the BMFA on who should have a Flyer ID and who shouldn't but at this stage of the year it all boils down to the following
